Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Passed class 8th and valid proof of attaining 14 years of age</li><li>2. Submit a self-certificate "I have studied enough to be able to pursue secondary course" is also eligible for admission to the Secondary Course</li><li>3. Student who has studied at the secondary level elsewhere can also seek admission either to complete the course or improve performance</li></ol>
Documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Birth certificate</li><li>2. Address proof- Aadhaar card/water bill/electricity bill/voter ID/ration card (any one)</li><li>3. Signature (preferably in black ink)</li><li>4. Recent passport size color photograph with current date and name printed</li><li>5. Class 8th marksheet/ Transfer Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate for NIOS 10th Admission</li><li>6. Disability certificate for PWD candidates (If you have)</li><li>7. Caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates (If you have)</li></ol>
Compulsory subjects	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Appear in a minimum of 5 subjects.</li><li>2. Can choose a maximum of 2 additional subjects along with the mandatory ones.</li></ol>
Compulsory subjects (Sample)	<p>Group A: Secondary Course offers a choice of languages i.e. English, Hindi, Urdu, Bengali, Telugu, Gujarati, Kannada, Punjabi, Nepali, Assamese, Marathi, Sanskrit, Malayalam, Odia, Arabic, Persian and Tamil.</p> <p>Group B: Mathematics, Science and Technology, Social Science, Economics, Business Studies, Home Science, Data Entry Operations, Psychology, Indian Culture and Heritage, Accountancy, Painting and Data Entry Operations.</p> <p>Student needs to choose a minimum of five subjects including at least one language or atmost two languages are compulsory.</p> <p><a href="https://nios.ac.in/online-course-material/secondary-courses.aspx">https://nios.ac.in/online-course-material/secondary-courses.aspx</a></p>
Supporting Documents for exempted categories	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. SC/ST candidates - copy of certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Magistrate or Commissioner SC/ST duly attested by a Gazetted Officer</li><li>2. Differently-abled persons - certificate from a Govt. Hospital, and not from a private nursing home, clearly indicating nature and extent of disability</li></ol>
