Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Minimum of 15 years of age</li><li>2. Should have passed the secondary (10th) exams</li><li>3. Should be enrolled with NIOS</li><li>4. Produce a secondary class pass certificate from NIOS/recognised Board along with address proof and two latest passport-size photographs</li></ol>
Documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Address proof- Aadhaar card/water bill/electricity bill/voter ID/ration card (any one)</li><li>2. Signature (preferably in black ink)</li><li>3. Recent passport size color photograph with current date and name printed</li><li>4. Class 10th marksheet to apply for NIOS 12th exams</li><li>5. Disability certificate for PWD candidates (if you have)</li><li>6. Caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates. (if you have)</li></ol>
Compulsory subjects	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Subjects include History, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Sociology, and so on</li><li>2. Students have to fill in their choice of NIOS Subjects for 12 during NIOS admissions</li><li>3. A minimum of 5 subjects with one or a maximum of 2 languages is compulsory</li></ol>
Compulsory subjects (Sample)	<p>NIOS subjects for class 12th are divided into six groups namely A, B, C, D, E and F.</p> <p>Group A: Hindi, English, Urdu, Sanskrit, Gujarati, Bengali, Tamil, Odia, Punjabi, Arabic, Persian, Malayalam</p> <p>Group B: Mathematics, Home Science, Psychology, Geography, Economics, Business Studies, Painting, Data Entry Operations, Early Childhood Care &amp; Education, Veda Adhyan, Sanskrit Vyakaran, Bharatiya Darshan, Sanskrit Sahitya</p> <p>Group C: Physics, History, Environmental Science, Library and Information, Science</p> <p>Group D: Chemistry, Political Science, Mass Communication, Military Studies</p> <p>Group E: Biology, Accountancy, Introduction to Law, Military History</p> <p>Group F: Computer Science, Sociology, Tourism, Physical Education and Yoga</p> <p>Students need to choose five subjects with either one or two languages from Group A and the remaining subjects from Group B, C, D, E and F (only one subject from each group C, D, E and F).</p> <p>Two additional subjects can be taken from any group (only one subject from each group C, D, E and F) with additional fee as per NIOS norms.</p> <p><a href="https://www.nios.ac.in/departmentsunits/academic/senior-secondary-course-equivalent-to-class-xii.aspx">https://www.nios.ac.in/departmentsunits/academic/senior-secondary-course-equivalent-to-class-xii.aspx</a></p>
Supporting Documents for exempted categories	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. SC/ST candidates - copy of certificate issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Magistrate or Commissioner SC/ST duly attested by a Gazetted Officer</li><li>2. Differently-abled persons - certificate from a Govt. Hospital, and not from a private nursing home, clearly indicating nature and extent of disability</li></ol>
